

What we offer



About Madrassa

- Islam4kids runs for 10 months from February to November and aims at transferring the basic values & principles of Islam in a fun & enjoyable approach making learning & understanding easy to grasp.
- Lessons include Islamic crafts which supports motor skills development in our young learners. Practical application, games, play & educational activities is included to aid the learning process & reinforce the knowledge build.
- Educational activities consist of lap- books, board-games, puzzles, dvd
 viewing, audio cd's, nasheeds, moral stories & visits to the Islamic library. A
 series of memory games & concentration building techniques are used in our
 classes to further aid memory & attention skills development. Knowledge
 transferral is done both deliberately & inconspicuously.

Subject Matter

Learning to read the Qur-aan

- Various techniques for improving the proficiency in reading is adopted.
- Learners progress at their own pace & are provided with one on one instruction.

Subjects

- We offer Islamic studies such as Figh, Tauheed, Etiquette, History, memorisation of surahs, du'as, hadith & Arabic vocab & writing.
- A detailed syllabus is available.



Our Classes Educators & Methods

Classes are kept small to provide individual attention to all learners.

All classes is facilitated by a main Educator as well as 1 or 2 class assistants.

We cater for grades R to 7.

Educators has prior Madrassa/Teaching experience & holds tertiary Islamic qualifications. They may have or in the process of attaining other tertiary qualifications such as Commerce or Education as well as Montessori Teaching Qualifications.

Prophetic teaching methodology is implemented by our Educators.

Events

- An annual excursion takes place in Ramadhaan to an old aged home, a children's home or an orphanage.
- An annual Moulood takes place during the year as indicated on our annual year calendar.
- An annual presentation is held on the last Saturday in November where all learners receive their individual certificates & reports.
- Small class events are held where individual learners enters reading in the Qur-aan during the year.



Communication

- All communication to parents is sent via email or phone messages.
- Admin sends reminders during the year.
 Whatsapp broadcast lists is set up for this purpose, parents to include the admin number (076-055-1437) as a contact in order to receive these messages.
- Educators communicates to parents on a weekly basis as required re.
 learner ongoing progress & requirements.
- Learners is provided with a reading record sheet to record weekly reading.
- Newsletters is emailed to parents during the year highlighting class activities, events & general information.

Boys:


White or black thobe with a matching fez.

Learner Safety

- Parents dropping off learners at the venue entrance to be in contact with the teacher to ensure that the learner has arrived in class.



Covid-19 Protocol

The following is compulsory for learners in 2021:

Learner Progress

- One on one parent meetings takes place in Mar/Apr with the relevant class Educator to discuss learner progress.
- A brief report is available mid year.
- A detailed report is available in November.



Fees Policy





- 2. Annual fees is raised with monthly statements sent to track fees account balances and record of payments.
- 3. Fees is due on a monthly basis on the 1^{st} , commencing from 1^{st} Feb to 1^{st} Nov, see fees structure for the monthly amounts.
- One month notification in writing is required when removing your child from the Madrassa.
- 5. Fees will remain payable up until and including the month in which the withdrawal notification is sent.
- 6. Credit balances & adjustments to the initial annual invoice will take place then.
- 7. Sibling discounts is offered. See Fees Structure.
- 8. A 7% discount on fees is offered when annual fees are paid on or before 01 February.
