Then, quench that need.



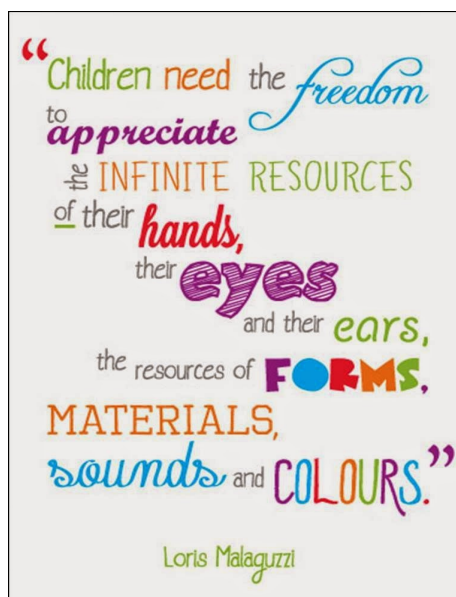
A TEACHER'S DUAA

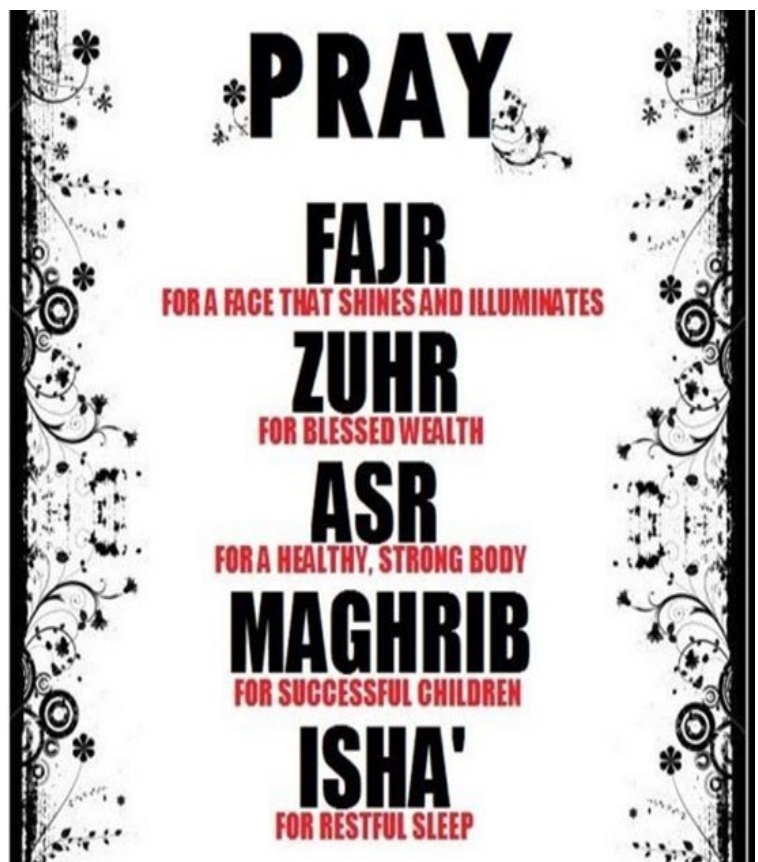
Laylatul Mi'raaj

In the Qur'an's 17th chapter, Surah al-Isra, there is a brief description of the physical journey of Israa' and Mi'raaj.

"Glory to Him Who carried his servant by night from the Sacred Mosque to the Furthest Mosque, whose precincts We have blessed, to show him Our signs! He is the One who is All-Hearing, All-Seeing!" - Ayah 1

The word ISRAA" refers to the nocturnal journey of Nabee Muhammad (S.A.W) from Makkah to Baitul Maqdis (Masjidul Aqsa) where He (S.A.W) led the Ambiyaa (A.S) in salaah.

The word MI'RAAJ refers to the ascension of Nabee Muhammad (S.A.W) with Angel Jibreel (A.S) on the Buraaq through the seven Heavens until the Sidratul Muntahaa i.e the Lote tree . This was the point of which Jibreel (A.S) as well as the Buraaq could not go any further. Then He (S.A.W) continued His journey into the Court of Allah . The distance between Him (S.A.W) and Allah was less than 2 bows lengths.



The discussion between Allah and His Messenger (S.A.W) was the Tashahhud of Salaah which includes greetings, praises and salutations. Thereafter Allah gave Him (S.A.W) the gift of 50 Salaahs which after meeting a few Ambiyaa, they (A.S) had advised Him (S.A.W) return back to Allah and have it reduced until it was 5.

The reward thereof is still that of one who would have performed 50 salaahs.

Nabee Muhammad (S.A.W) is reported to have said : " The first matter that the slave will be brought to account for on the day of Judgement is PRAYER. If it is sound, then the rest of his deeds will be sound and if it is bad then the rest of his deeds will be bad." - HADITH

"Command your children to perform prayer when they become seven years old, and beat them for (not performing) it (i.e. prayer) when they become ten years old; and arrange their beds (so that boys and girls sleep) separately."

[Ahmad, At-Tirmithi, Abu Dawood]

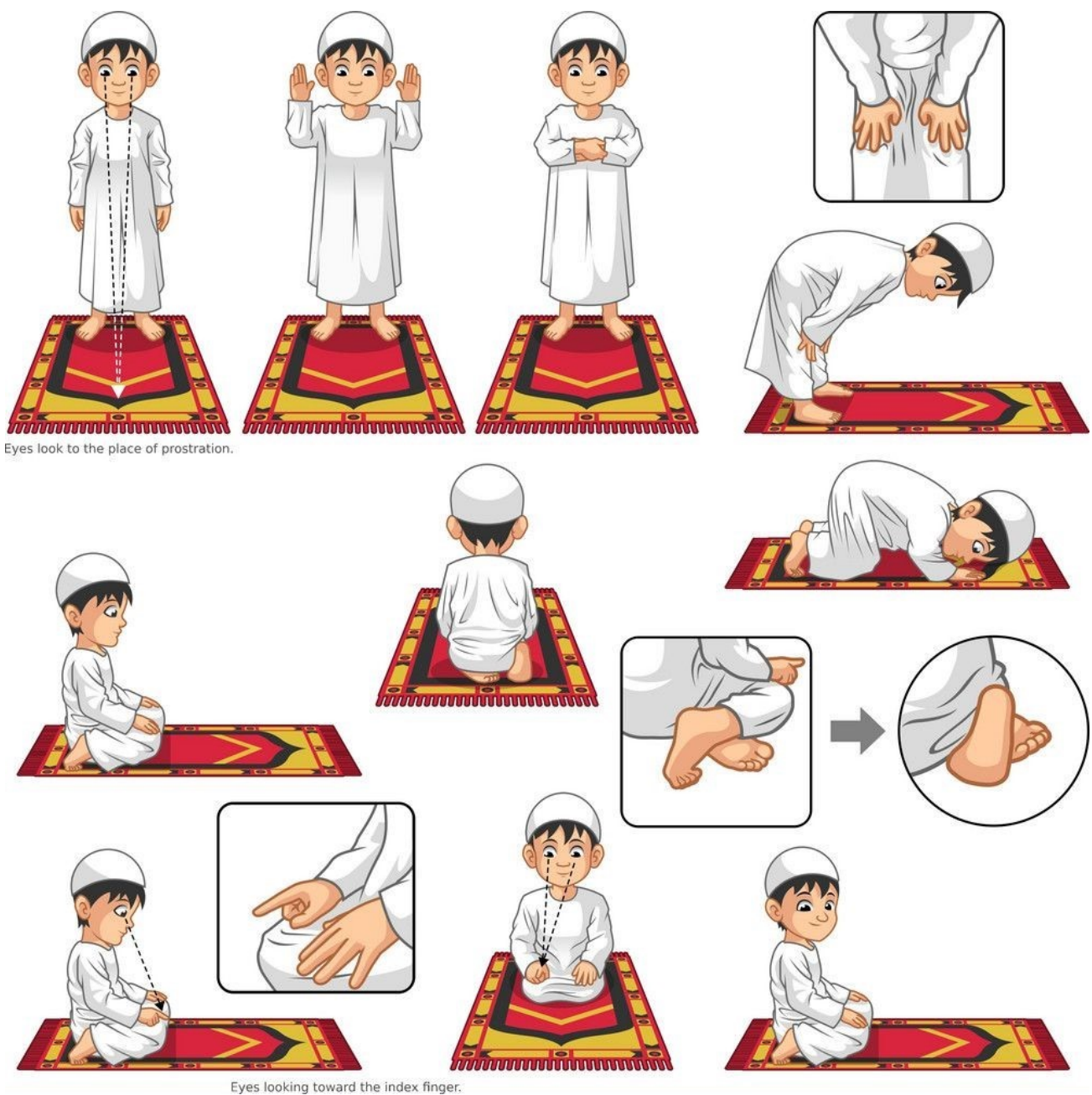
- ⇒ Salaah is the second pillar of Islaam
